#### COURSE IN HOSPITAL

Patient admitted in hospital through casualty on 26.03.2020 under Dr. A.K. Verma with above mentioned complaints. After Initial evaluation as per standardised protocol treatment initiated with IV fluids, IV antibiotics, IV PPI, IV Antiemetics, Antipyretic, Analgesic, Dressing and other supportive treatment also given. All necessary investigations were done. Pateint gradually responded well to given treatment, condition of pateint has improved. Today patient is being discharged with following advice and medication.
